BAA Heathrow, in partnership with Abellio Surrey, is investing in this route as part of its Freeflow Heathrow campaign to encourage use of public transport.



Hop on the 555 the convenient 'green way' to travel between Walton-on-Thames and Heathrow. From 31st October, buses now run even earlier with the first arrival at Heathrow now at 0400.

## Getting around by bus

Buses run from Walton-on-Thames Station, Walton-on-Thames, Shepperton, Sunbury Village, Sunbury Cross Shopping Centre, Sunbury Tesco, Ashford Common, Ashford Hospital, Stanwell, Terminal 4, Hatton Cross Bus Station, Harlington Corner and Heathrow Airport Central Bus Station. Route 557 provides an hourly link to Chertsey, St Peter's Hospital and Addlestone from Hatton Cross via Upper Halliford.

Route 555 is a great link to National Rail, the Underground and Heathrow Airport, with buses all day they are great for work or leisure.

555 Buses have low floor easy access and have special facilities for wheelchairs and areas for shopping trolleys and buggies.

- Use your Oyster card, Oyster card holders only pay £1.20 (from Jan 2010) cash single fare (valid between Sunbury Cross and Heathrow)
- Senior citizens and Surrey concessionary pass holders travel for free on the 555 (after 09.00) Monday-Friday and at all times Saturday and Sunday.
- BAA Airport Travelcard holders can use their Travelcard on the route.

## Catching the bus

- Go to a 555 stop, signal clearly to the driver that you want the bus as the bus approaches.
- Pay your fare to the driver when on board, change is available, but it would help if you have the correct fare.
- Please hold the handrails whilst walking on the bus.
- Press the bell once as you near your stop and remain seated until the bus stops.
